In addition to in-hospital rehabilitation for acute care, we are also involved in continuous rehabilitation protocols to help regain function, improve the quality of life and prognosis of patients living with chronic Cardiopulmonary Conditions and following debilitating illness. We follow an evidence-based approach in planning and management of patient rehabilitation. Not only do we rehabilitate patients following an injury, we also incorporate multiple Health promotion in high risk populations as a prevention strategy.

The department of cardiovascular and Respiratory Physiotherapy undertakes treatment and early mobilisation in the ICU's of Smt. Kashibai Navale General Hospital namely the Medical ICU, Surgical ICU, Respiratory ICU, Paediatric and Neonatal ICU, Pulmonary Rehabilitation, Cardiac Rehabilitation, post surgical patient rehabilitation. The Department also provides specialised physiotherapy services to the patients admitted under Surgery, Medicine, Pulmonary Medicine, ENT, Paediatrics, Orthopaedics, Gynaecology and obstetrics Departments at the SKNGH.
